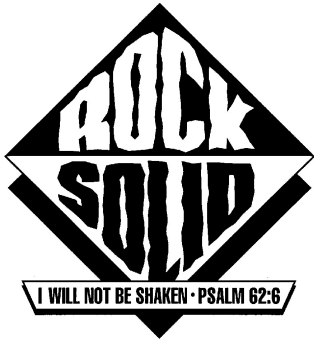

You probably already know what to bring, but here's a list just in case. Don't forget to read the camp policies and see what you shouldn't bring to camp - remember NO CELL PHONES.

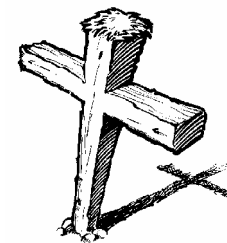
- Bible, paper, pen or pencil

Camp Policies & Registration

As a church, we believe that Good Shepherd youth are called to live the words Paul wrote to Timothy "Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith and in purity...devote yourself to the public reading of scripture, to preaching and to teaching.
