I. Who is Jeremiah?

- Commissioned in his mother's womb. (Jer. 1:5)
- Served as God's prophet under the last 5 kings of Judah for more than 40 years.
- Main theme: Repent and come back to God. (spoken more than 100 times!)

II. Peace in the storm (Jer. 29: 5-9)

- Are we going home soon God?
- Settle in.
- Seek peace.
- Increase/not decrease.

III. A glimmer of hope – A New Covenant is coming

- I will establish a new covenant (Jer. 31:31-34)
- I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts;
- I will be their God, and they will be My people.
- They shall ALL know Me...says the Lord.

IV. Jesus our hope (John 14:18-29)

- I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.
- Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid!
- I will give you My peace in all circumstances, at all times, in all places...My peace is not of this world!
